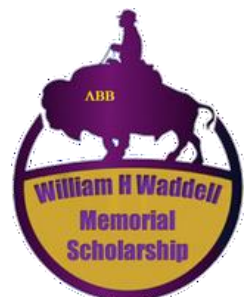

- 3 letters of Recommendation (All letters should be reflective of activities during your junior and/or senior years of school. (All letters must be dated.))
  - One letter from a community service organization or other institution, on official letterhead, describing your community involvement. Community involvement must be of a voluntary nature and cannot be compensated.
  - One letter from a high school/college teacher or official, on official letterhead, regarding your performance in school and extra-curricular activities.
  - One character reference letter from someone other than a relative.
- An **OFFICIAL SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT**:  
Transcript must be emailed directly from the school to [admin@lbbques.com](mailto:admin@lbbques.com). Transcripts must be the most current available
- A (700-750) word original essay on the topic

**The essay MUST be written in APA style or it will not be considered.**

## **Eligibility Requirements**

- Candidate must be a high school senior that has received acceptance to an accredited four-Year College or University.
- Candidate must be a United States citizen or permanent United States Resident.
- Candidate must have demonstrated academic achievement with a high school minimum cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.5 or higher for the general scholarship.
- To compete for the **William H. Waddell Scholarship**, students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 and demonstrated success in STEM education.
